Tours of the Howarth workshops run from 2:00pm - 4:30pm and last approximately 30 minutes each.

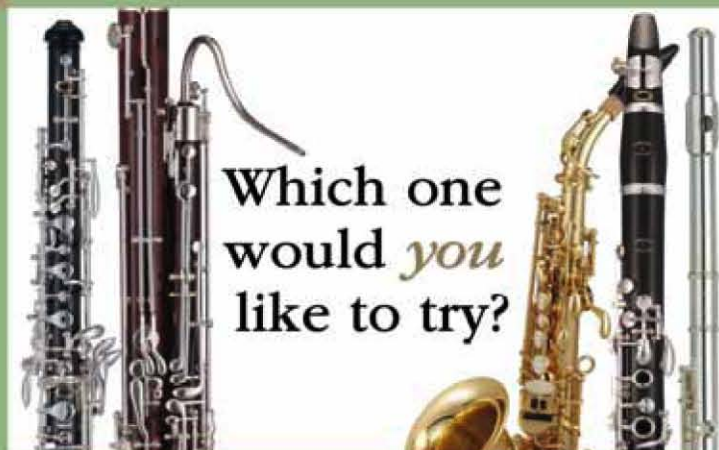
